Apply for Free School Meals and Uniform Grant TODAY!

If you are in receipt of one of the following: -

- Income Support;
- Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance;
- The Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable income of £16,190 or less.

Or: -

- If you are an Asylum Seeker supported by the Home Office National Asylum Support Service (NASS); or
- If your child has a statement of special educational needs and is designated to require a special diet.

You should contact your school or your local Education Authority Region to request an application form. Forms are also available in your local Social Security Office or Citizens Advice Bureau Office.

NOTE:

- 1 Listed above Free School Meals / School Uniform/ Physical Education Clothing eligibility criteria for the school year 2015-16 commencing 1 September 2015;
- 2 Pupils must be in full-time education at school/college;
- 3 The Clothing Scheme does not apply to pupils in attendance at Nursery Schools / Nursery Units / Reception Class / Independent Schools or to pupils eligible under the special diet criterion.
